

The panel is secured by a rim lock with a key provided or can be individually keyed for maximum security.


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


90 MINUTE, WALL HINGED, FIRE RATED ACCESS HATCH FIXING DETAIL:

- 1. Mark out and cut opening in the wall. NB. Trimmed opening to be 4mm (Nom.) greater than hatch intended to be installed.
- 2. Frame opening with steel studs or trimmers. Ensure studs or trimmers are connected to studs or wall support system. Line the studs or trimmers with fire rated board of the same thickness as the fire exposed face.
- 3. Match access panel to the opening.
- 4. Open the hatch/panel and secure frame to the studs or trimmers with steel screws on all 4 sides of the hatch in the holes provided. For masonry installations use 60x6mm masonry anchors.For 'Set Bead' installations remove the hatch/panel and flush set. Return hatch/panel into the frame and test operation. Ensure the hinge screws are tightened.
- 5. While the hatch/panel is open apply fire rated mastic sealant to any gaps between the access hatch frame and the inside reveal of the wall opening.
- 6. Close the hatch/panel and engage the lock.
