Oakwood Collection is a tribute to the colours, the textures and forms found in nature and how we bring the outdoors into our spaces – whether that be the home or the workplace, the everyday or that special space. The organic profiles will inspire the creation of spaces that welcome you, inviting you to inhabit them and feel the warmth of natural beauty, designed by nature, underfoot.

A premium engineered timber, Oakwood is designed with quality craftmanship in a beautiful and sustainable way. Finished at a large-scale dimension of 2200mm x 220mm, this superior sized board is stocked in 15 nature inspired colours honouring the sensibilities of oak.

Foster a kinship between the built world and natural landscapes and explore the language of timber with Oakwood.

Charming in character and trusted for its strength, oak is a hardwood timber favoured for its superior qualities designed to withstand the challenges and changes of time.

Oak is known to be a hard and dense wood that is less likely to dent or scratch – compared to softer timbers – making it an obvious choice for flooring. Durable and able to endure everyday wear and tear, it is easy to maintain with regular cleaning and minimal effort, retaining both its beauty and strength.

Oakwood's large-scale boards are a key feature of the collection, offering a more contemporary aesthetic. Designed at 2200mm in length and 220mm wide, the 15mm thick construction features a 4mm solid hardwood top layer, 5 ply core and stabilising base layer for the ultimate foundation. Formed to retain the shape and stability of the board, the engineered core provides considerable dimensional stability meaning it is less prone to expand or contract with humidity and temperature changes, reducing the risk of warping or gaps forming. In addition, the core is made up from cross layers of timber running perpendicular to the sheet above and below for even more strength.

The power and strength of oak

With a tongue and groove locking system, these timber boards are recommended to be direct stuck but can also be installed as a floating floor where possible.

A perfect blend and balance of utility and beauty.

Crafted using real timber, Oakwood is made with an appreciation for natures every detail, accentuating the alluring beauty of oak.

The natural and distinctive appearance of oak is honoured by using the hardwoods every component in the manufacturing process. Ultimately reducing waste while preserving the character and charm of this organic resource.

With natures arrangement of never-ending patterns, grains and shades of colour, no two planks are the same. Because of this, Oakwood boards are characterised by an A, B, C, D grading. An 'A Grade' board is the most refined in appearance. It represents approximately 10% of the timber harvested from the average oak tree and contains very few, if any knots and no sapwood, resulting in a clearer grain with a more consistent appearance. The boards appearance and character gradually progress through to 'D Grade' boards which are the most varied in colour and grain and allows the most knots and sapwood. Cartons are packed in an assortment of grading.

Overall, Oakwood offers a refined and smooth appearance with a matte finish that is achieved with 3 layers of Teknos technology - an eco-friendly UV coating emitting no VOC's. The brushed finish is absorbed into the façade of the board softly revealing the sympathetic grain to showcase the organic lines and texture of oak, while also providing added resistance against dirt and stains.

Explore the beauty and wonder of nature's imperfections with Oakwood.

Ethically sourced and with longevity in mind, Oakwood engineered timber boards have been created with attention to detail, timeless design elements and using the highest quality resources to last the test of time.

The process is more than just a finished timber board, it is careful consideration of how the timber is grown and replenished, and understanding how the natural resource can be used to maximise the quality of the boards while minimising any waste and reducing the impact on the environment.

Oakwood's top layer is made from a solid European oak, while the core is made of multi ply eucalyptus layers. Where there is an abundance of one resource over the other, saving the oak for the surface of the board and changing the timber variety in the core means a better use of resources. The result is a more sustainable product.






